While the purpose of the initiative is usage for childcare providers, the kits could also be utilized by teachers and parents. Each kit comes in an easy to store tote.



Activity Kit Descriptions

Infant Individual Learning Kit (retail value \$159)

Description: This kit is filled with essential, age-appropriate materials to help each infant reach developmental milestones through play. Plus, everything included is baby-safe and easy to clean. Recommended Age: 6 mos. - 36 mos.



Toddler Individual Learning Kit (retail value \$179)

Description: This kit is filled with essential, age-appropriate materials to help each toddler reach developmental milestones through play. Plus, everything included is toddler-safe and easy to clean. Recommended Age: 18 mos. - 36 mos.



Storytelling Kit (retail value \$380)

Recommended Age: 3 yrs. - 7 yrs. / Preschool - 2nd gr.

Description: These delightful kits are packed with all the cloth characters and props you need to bring 6 children's stories to life! Each kit includes all the pieces needed to tell the story. The kit includes a magnetic storytelling board and hardcover books.
